YOU ARE INVITED The Nova Scotia Nonprofit Sector Research Project in conjunction with Phoenix Youth Programs and the Federation of Community Organizations is hosting a series of local information meetings to determine the direction of the Nonprofit Sector within the Province. The project seeks input from individuals and organizations working within the nonprofit community to chart the course moving forward.

KEY TOPICS Stemming from current labour market research and data collected at the Provincial Conference (Oct. 2010), a number of priorities have been identified including:

- **Sector representation** – *Is there a homegrown model effective for Nova Scotians?*
- **Resource management** – *How can sharing services benefit our service delivery?*
- **Capacity building** – *What training is most needed to assist Non Profits to thrive?*

These meetings will allow us to explore the findings and develop the recommendations that will guide the sector through the next steps. Comprising over 6% of the Nova Scotian economy, the Nonprofit sector affects everyone, everyday.
